#### Hunger Banquet ~ April 4th

You will notice on the hot lunch order form on Tuesday, April 4th the words "Hunger Banquet." On this day, every student will eat hot lunch for free. Please do not send a cold lunch. **Preschool students will need to be picked up by noon as they will not participate in this activity.**

The Hunger Banquet is a annual tradition at SPPS. On this day, students learn about world hunger by being divided into 3 groups, which correspond to the percent of the world's countries and their economic status. Ten percent of the students represent the advanced developed countries of the world and are fed a banquet! Thirty percent of the students represent developed world countries and are fed adequately, a meat patty and some vegetables. Sixty percent represent the world's developing countries and are fed a small bowl of rice. The students are fed only what is listed, however, after lunch recess the rice students are offered a nutri-grain bar and an apple.

**Please note:** Students and staff are chosen by the luck of the draw. Most (60%) of the students will experience being hungry! Be prepared with an after school snack!

Extend the lesson by discussing with your child/children about how blessed we are to live in a developed country and have adequate food supplies.
