Sports Eligibility

SPPS students taking part in extracurricular activities at Sts. Peter & Paul School or Grangeville Elementary School must maintain a C average & have no F's in any subject. An ineligible student may, through makeup work or redo's (as already defined in each classroom policy) become eligible as soon as his/her grades meet the C average requirement. For the first Friday of grading period, the prior two weeks of grades will be used for determining eligibility. Eligibility checks will be made & notification given every Friday. If a student is ineligible, the teacher will notify the principal first, then the parents & the coach.
