

~ UNIFORM POLICY ~

Sts. Peter & Paul School have a uniform policy. The purpose of the uniform policy is to promote modesty, responsibility, morality and unity. The uniform policy is:

Navy blue or khaki colored pants. (no jeans or cargo pants.)

Pants must be worn at the waist.

Girls can also wear jumpers, skorts, and skirts.

Note: no white pants, skirts, etc.

White or navy blue polo or button shirts/blouses.

(Classic polo shirts or classic button down shirts are preferred.)

Note: no khaki shirts or blouses

Cardigans, sweaters, suit jackets, ties & vests (if worn) must be white or navy blue.

Belts (if worn) must be solid black, brown or navy and worn in the belt loops.

Tights/leggings and socks (if they show) must be in solid, uniform colors, must be covered with appropriate length skirts or shorts (worn only at the appropriate time of year).

All shirts or blouses are to have collars and must be at least a hand-width in length below the waist of your pants, skorts, skirts or shorts.

Shorts, skirts, and skorts must be a *minimum* of fingertip length.

Yoga pants, lounge pants, sweatpants, and athletic pants/shorts that are form fitting are not acceptable.

Only uniform clothing to be worn in the classroom (no non-uniform coats, jackets, sweatshirts, sweaters, etc.) Clothing must be in good repair.

The school logo may be printed on the shirts and or sweatshirts, and all SPPS logos are acceptable. Other logos are to be no larger than 1" in height and length.

Shorts may be worn in Aug./Sept. and May/June, weather permitting. Flip-flops will not be permitted. Students should have proper clothing for winter outdoor activities, i.e. boots, hats and gloves.

Athletic wear, especially designed for gym activities are not permitted to be worn in the classroom. Students participating in team activities may wear their team uniform top (with a collared shirt worn underneath) on event days.

When students leave the school for field trips, service projects, SPPS team games, etc., they are still representing Sts. Peter & Paul School. The uniform policy is to be followed. Exceptions must be cleared by the Principal.

Dress and appearance must not present health or safety problems or pose potential disruption of the educational process as determined by school personnel and governed by SPPS uniform policy. Teachers shall call parents on the first infraction of uniform policy. Parents will bring suitable clothing for the student on request or appropriate clothing will be given from the uniform rack, if available.

UNIFORM POLICY FOR MASS ATTENDANCE~

Shirts and blouses are to be tucked in during Mass.

No shorts or sweatshirts are to be at Mass days.

No non-uniform outerwear (to include coats, jackets, sweatshirts and sweaters) are to be worn during Mass.

Accessories (of any kind) must not be distracting to the learning environment.

Faculty judgment will prevail on questions of appropriate clothing & accessories.
